

Needles and Artifice Errata

The Ladies sincerely apologize for the following errors. It has become clear to us that version 1.7 of the Mechanical Knitting Pattern Verification Engine needs some additional refinement. The explosion was impressive, however our mechanists have managed to reconstruct and begin work on version 2.0. In the meantime, please reference the following pages for illumination and elucidation.

Chapter 1 - Mechanical

Resilience Top

Page 24:

“Row 12 (ws): k2, k2tog, work **in pattern to last 3 stitches, slip the last 3 stitches pwise wyif.**”

Page 26:

“Work in established pattern, with slipped stitch edging on both edges, for 37 (41, 27, 32, 34, 26) more rows, or until front measures **5 (5 1/2, 5 3/4, 6 1/2, 6 3/4, 7 1/2)** inches from armhole bindoff without stretching. **End on a ws row.**”

Chapter 3 - Airship

Legacy Frock Coat

Page 102:

“Enter your gauge in the following calculations:

Total bicep stitches: stitch gauge ___ x Bicep measurement in inches ___ +12 = ___ stitches”

Page 104:

“Work even in stockinette in the round for **30 (31, 29, 34, ___)** rows/**5 1/2 (5 1/2, 5 1/4, 6, ___)** inches, **or until sleeve reaches your armpit.**”

“Work even in stockinette in the round for **34, ___** rows/**6, ___** inches, **or until sleeve reaches your armpit.**”

Flat decrease:

“NOTE: All decreases are worked on one side of the garment, along the bottom edge of the back.

XS (S, M, L, 1X):

Row 1 (ws): p2tog, p to end.

Row 2 (rs): k to end.

Row 3 (ws): p to end.

Row 4 (rs): knit to last two stitches, k2tog.



Page 105:

“Flat Increase:

XS (S, M, L, 1X):

Row 1 (rs): knit to last stitch, m1k, k1.

Row 2 (ws): p to end.

Row 3 (rs): k to end.

Row 4 (ws): pfb, p to end.

Row 5 (rs): k to end.

Row 6 (ws): p to end.

Repeat these six rows two more times.

Total stitches: **40** (40, 42, 46, 50, ___)”

“All sizes:

Rejoin to work in the round.

Work in stockinette for 11½ (12, **5½, 5½, 5 ¼, 6, 6, 6, 6, ___**) inches/63 (66, 30, **31, 29, 34, 34, 34, 34, ___**) rows, or until the straight section of the sleeve matches the straight section of the other sleeve.”

Page 106:

“Repeat this row **94** (94, 94, 92, **92, 94, 96, 100, 106, ___**) times, **47** (47, 47, 46, 46, 47, 48, 50, 53, ___)

times each side or until sweater tail is the desired length.”

Chapter 4 – Countryside

Abundance Vest

Page 135:

“YARN AND YARDAGE:

Regale by Fiberstory,

<http://fiberstory.etsy.com>

80% merino, 10% cashmere, 10% nylon; 181yds (165m) per 113g; aran weight

Color: Ha’penny, 4 (5, 7, 8, 9, 10) skeins”


Mountain Lily Scarf

Page 124:

“CHART NOTES:

Knit the first and last 3 stitches of every row. Chart does not include these 6 edge stitches. Repeat the outlined section of the chart one time (or more if you choose to add repeats to your width) before working remainder of the row.”

Chart error: Row 3, center repeat section: 4th and 8th stitches should be yarn overs (currently they’re knit stitches)



Chapter 5 – High Society

Cameo Spencer Jacket

Page 170:

Total stitches (after side increases **and completing the increases for the right front edge**): 194 (205, 215, 226, 236, 256, 266, 277)

Right Front:

Total right front stitches: 71 (74, 76, 79, 81, 87, 90, 92)

NOTE: If your row gauge is off, your stitch count may differ due to the rounded edge shaping. **Use the side seam marker to determine the front edge stitches.**

Page 172:

Begin Puff Shoulder:

Increase row: kfb, *k1, m1r,* rep between * to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, sm, work

chain, sm, ssk, *k1, m1r,* rep between * to last 2 sts, kfb, k1.

“Total stitches: 105 (109, 118, 126, 130, 134, 139, 141)” should be:

“**Total stitches: 113 (117, 126, 138, 142, 146, 155, 157)**”

“Begin to work flat, **continuing chain pattern and working the other stitches in stockinette.**”

Begin Armhole Shaping:

BO 5 sts at beginning of next two rows.

BO 3 sts at beginning of next two rows.

Total stitches: 97 (101, 110, 122, 126, 130, 139, 141)

RS decrease row:

K to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, sm, work chain pattern, sm, ssk, k to end.

Continue to work in established pattern, and repeat decrease row every 20 (12, 13, 9, 10, 8, 7, 6) rows 2 (4, 4, 6, 6, 8, 9, 10) times. When decrease row falls on a purl row, perform the following:


WS decrease row:

P2tog, work in established pattern to last 2 stitches, p2tog.

Total stitches: 91 (91, 100, 108, 112, 112, 119, 119)

Right Front before armhole:

69, 72, 74, 77, 79, 84, 88, 90



Chapter 6 – Mad Science

Eccentricity Stockings

Page 212:

“100% merino; 230yds (210m) per 113g; worsted weight”

Page 215:

“**PM**, pick up 10 sts from heel flap, pick up 2 sts at top of heel flap, pm, k22, __, pm, pick up 2 sts at top of flap, pick up 10 sts on heel flap, **pm**, p5.”

Amplitude Stockings

Page 217:

“100% merino; 230yds (210m) per 113g; worsted weight”

Deviation Capelet

Page 224:

“Color: Campari Orange, 1 (1, 2) skeins.”
